

Indianapolis Zoo Internships and Volunteer Information

Interns receive hands-on experiences in a variety of departments and gain a better understanding of careers in zoos and aquariums. Cleaning exhibits and holding areas, preparing diets, and assisting with observations and record keeping are daily components of an animal care internship.

Students in their junior or senior years, as well as recent graduates, can apply for one of three sessions: winter/spring, summer, and fall. Internships are currently available to students studying within the United States only. Typically, interns work 20–40 hours per week for a minimum of 12 consecutive weeks, depending on the position.
