

WildCare Inc. is now accepting applications for animal care internships.

Time Commitments:

Summer Internships run from May to August, with three days of mandatory training before the start date. The chosen interns must commit to work a minimum of 16 weeks, 20–40 hours per week, and be available on holidays, nights and weekends. We try to set the schedules so that you can still attend summer classes or work part-time. Spring and Fall internships follow IU's academic school year. These internships many times can be shortened to 10–15 hours a week during our off season.

What we are looking for:

Interns must be able to lift a minimum of 25lbs., stand for periods of time for at least 30 minute intervals, be able to read and follow instructions, perform simple calculations and have dependable transportation. Interns will need to supply proof of current tetanus (within last seven years). This position may not be suitable for individuals who are immune suppressed.

Training:

Interns must participate in orientation and complete formal training sessions prior to beginning intern duties and responsibilities. Dates will be provided once you are accepted into the program.

Compensation:

This internship is unpaid and housing is not provided.

Applicants for Internship:

Applications are due by March 15 for Summer Internships, August 1 for Fall, and January 5 for Spring. We will continue to accept applications until all positions are full. Go to our website, wildcareinc.org, to download the application.

- Letter of Intent detailing what you hope to gain from the internship
