## Minutes

Bloomington Faculty Council Minutes for October 19, 2021

- 1. The Bloomington Faculty Council held its regular biweekly meeting on Tuesday afternoon, October 19, 2021, in Presidents Hall. With Interim Provost John S. Applegate as Presiding Officer in the chair and Professor Spang acting as secretary, the meeting convened at 2:30 p.m. and the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.
- 2. Vice-Provost for Faculty and Academic Affairs Eliza Pavalko offered a <u>memorial resolution</u> for Professor W. Eugene Kleinbauer (1937-2019).
- 3. Professor DeSawal, on behalf of the Student Affairs Committee, proposed <u>revisions</u> to the academic misconduct policies in the Student Code of Conduct (*second reading; action item*).
- 4. Professor Deliyannis moved an amendment changing the possible outcome of an appeal to "uphold, reduce, or increase sanction." Discussion followed. The amendment failed on a show-of-hands vote.
- 5. Professor Thomassen moved to refer the policy back to the Student Affairs Committee for further revision. Discussion followed. The amendment failed on a show-of-hands vote.
- 6. Professor Eskew moved an amendment clarifying the proof standard and locus of the burden of proof. Discussion followed. Professor Eskew withdrew her amendment.
- 7. By a show-of-hands vote the Council **approved** the revisions to the Student Code of Conduct. (new policy—will take effect with the Fall 2022 semester.)
- 8. The meeting adjourned at 4:08 p.m.
