Readings and Research Course Forms-Instructions for Students

If you would like to take GEOG-X 473 Internship, GEOG-X 490 Readings, GEOG-G 830 Readings in Geography, or GEOG-G840 Research in Geography, please begin by discussing it with the faculty member you wish to be your instructor. Once they have agreed, will download the appropriate form from the <u>Faculty + Staff Intranet</u>.

Work with the professor to complete the form. This is an important step as it ensures both of you agree about expectations for the work you will complete during the semester. Once you are in agreement about the content of the form, both of you sign it.

Give the original signed copy to the Graduate Student Coordinator. They will keep a physical copy and give a physical copy to both you and the instructor.
