

## **Bachelor of Science in Music and an Outside Field (Ballet Emphasis)**

This curriculum provides a double focus in music and another area.

**Major Ensemble X** 30 Ballet Ensemble (2 cr.) *required every fall and spring semester in which student is registered.*

**Performance Study** J400 Ballet, minimum of 5 credit hours each semester until the graduation examination is completed. Entrance audition, upper division examination, graduation examination.

**Ballet Major Courses** 16 credit hours.
