C.P.E. Bach Sonata in G, H. 550, first or second movement

J.S. Bach Flute Sonata in E-Flat Major, BWV 1031, Any of the three movements are OK

Gaubert *Berceuse*, play from beginning through C<sup>7</sup> chord at *cédez* on p. 5

Mozart *Andante* in C (piano reduction by Boehm. You can stop where the opening flute melody returns)

Reinecke Flute Sonata, Op. 167 (3<sup>rd</sup> movt: Andante tranquillo. You can stop at the Molto vivace)
