STATEMENT CONDEMNING RUSSIAN MILITARY ATTACK ON UKRAINE

We, faculty, students, staff, and other affiliates of the R. F. Byrnes Russian and East European Institute, the Russian Studies Workshop, the Ostrom Workshop, the Center for Refugee Studies, the Ukrainian Studies Organization and other international institutes and programs at Indiana University condemn in the strongest terms the Russian military attack on the state of Ukraine. We express our deep concern for the safety and welfare of the Ukrainian people and call on international agencies and surrounding countries to ensure the welfare of Ukrainians fleeing the conflict. The unprovoked, unjustified attack on an independent state by the Russian Federation is an affront to international law and jeopardizes the post-World War II international order. We uphold Ukraine's sovereignty and its right to choose its own alliances, and call on Russia and the EU to respect the rights of non-combatant citizens.

Переклад українською (Translation into Ukrainian)

Ми, викладачі, студенти та співробітники Інституту Росії та Східної Європи імені Р. Ф. Бірнса, Семінару російських студій, Семінару Остромів, Центру досліджень біженців, Організації українських студій та інших міжнародних інститутів і програм Університету Індіани рішуче засуджуємо російський військовий напад на Україну. Ми надзвичайно занепокоєні безпекою та матеріально-побутовим становищем українського народу і закликаємо міжнародні агенції та сусідні країни забезпечити добробут українців, які рятуються від збройного конфлікту. Неспровокований напад Російської Федерації на незалежну державу, якому немає виправдання, є зневагою до міжнародного права. Він ставить під загрозу міжнародний устрій, сформований після Другої світової війни. Ми підтримуємо суверенітет України та її право обирати власних союзників, а також закликаємо Росію та ЄС поважати права громадян, які не воюють.

Перевод на русский (Translation into Russian)

Мы, преподаватели, студенты и сотрудники Института России и Восточной Европы им. Р. Ф. Бирнса, Семинара российских исследований, Рабочей группы имени Остромов, Центра исследований беженцев, Студенческой организации украинистов и других международных институтов и программ Индианского университета, решительно осуждаем военное нападение Российской Федерации на Украину. Мы выражаем глубокую озабоченность по поводу безопасности и благополучия украинского народа и призываем международные агентства и соседние страны обеспечить благополучие украинцев, спасающихся бегством от конфликта. Неспровоцированное и неоправданное нападение Российской Федерации на независимое государство является оскорблением международного права и ставит под угрозу международный порядок, сложившийся после Второй мировой войны. Мы поддерживаем суверенитет Украины и

ее право на вступление в любые альянсы по собственному выбору и призываем Россию и ЕС уважать права мирных граждан.
