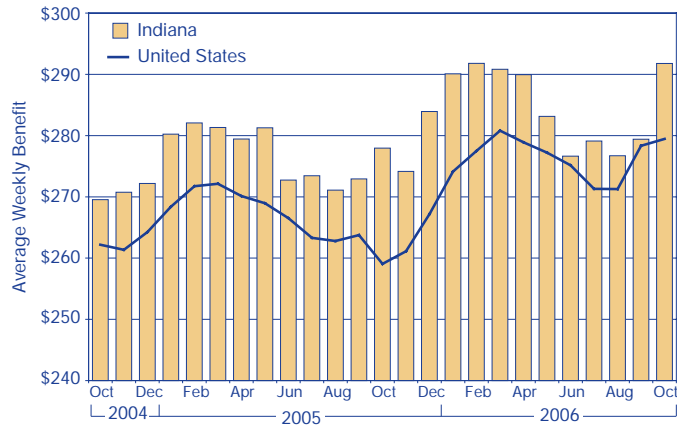


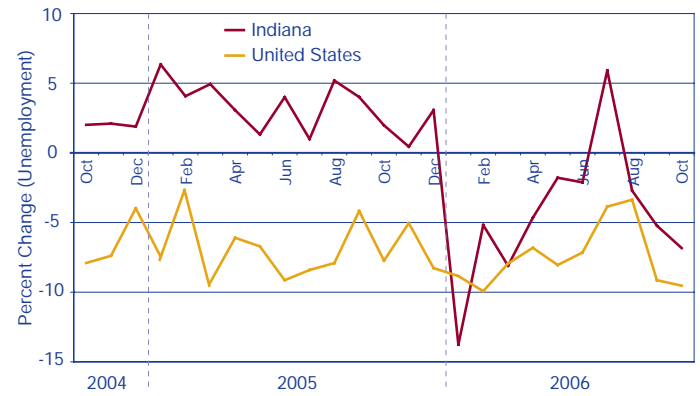

AVERAGE BENEFITS PAID FOR UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE CLAIMS



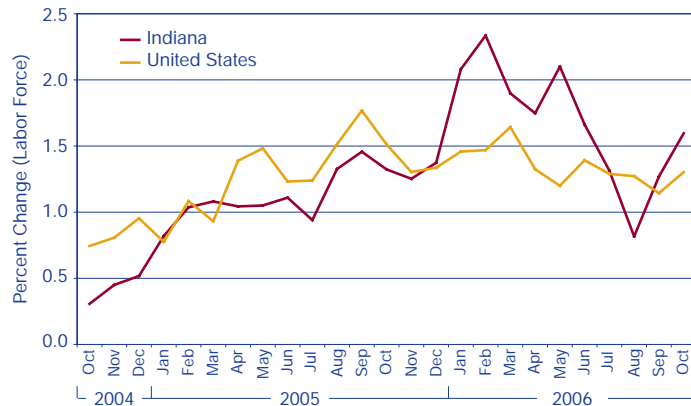

PERCENT CHANGE IN UNEMPLOYMENT FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR*



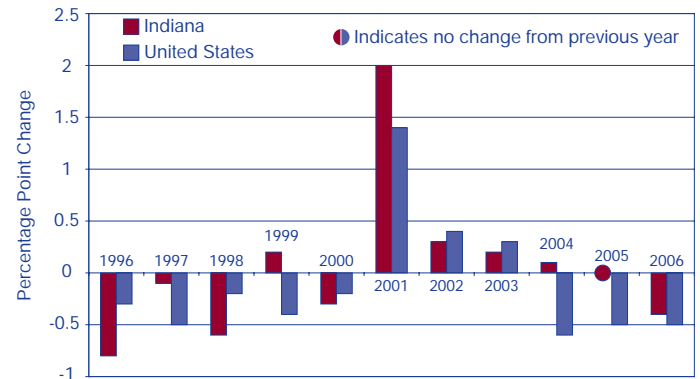

CHANGE IN UNEMPLOYMENT RATE FROM OCTOBER OF PREVIOUS YEAR*



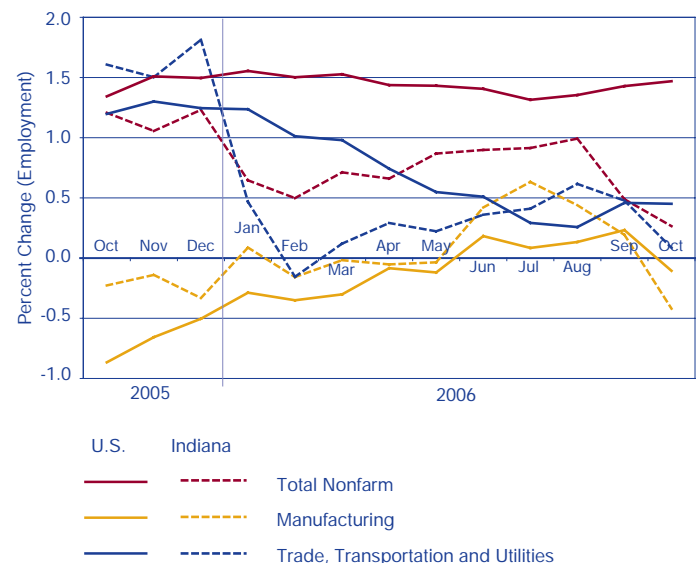
